About Rural and Regional Council.

Rural and Regional Council is a forum within the Liberal Party of Australia (SA Division) interested in the concerns and welfare of regional and rural people.

The Council holds bi-monthly meetings and other events throughout the year in addition to offering assistance and support to election candidates.

Minutes of meetings are forwarded to all members together with Council's newsletter, Rural Briefing.

The President of the Council is a member of the Liberal Party's State Executive and a delegate to the Federal Council.

In addition, the Council elects 12 delegates to State Council, the governing body of the South Australian Liberal Party.

Our history.

In 1938 the Liberal and Country League formed the Primary Producers' Committee to represent the large proportion of its members who derived their income from the land.

Later changes to the organisation broadened its membership and brought a change of name to the Rural Committee. In the 1980s and 1990s the body became more inclusive of the State's major regional centres and changed its name to Rural and Regional Council.

The Council maintains successful working relationships with non-metropolitan Members of Parliament, Ministers and Shadow Ministers. Links have also been maintained with the South Australian Farmers Federation and other rural and regional bodies.



Getting involved.

Rural and Regional Council seeks to bring together members of the South Australian Liberal Party, who have membership of a branch outside of the metropolitan area.

Membership of the Council provides an opportunity to build relationships with Liberal Members of Parliament and other like minded party members in a casual atmosphere.

Members involved in Council cover a wide range of occupations including primary production, small business, manufacturing and professional people.
